On Thursday 1st June I had the privilege of attending the Mayor's Morning Tea for Ministers in Toowoomba. About 50 ministers were able to attend from churches all over Toowoomba. The Mayor Paul Antonio thanked all the leaders gathered for their church's work in helping the community, and he reflected that although at times there had been differences between churches that we were all working for the betterment of the city of Toowoomba and its people.

Last week was also the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, and I had the pleasure of being part of the ecumenical service at St. Alban's Anglican church in West Toowoomba.

As I reflect on these occasions, I'm reminded of the need for all people of goodwill to work together for the common good. Churches have often worked in silos and thought only about 'their own patch'. As we are starting to see, the creative Spirit of God sees through the boundaries we impose, and calls us into deeper waters of relationship and connection.

I truly believe that if Lifeworks is to flourish and reach our full potential, it will come from our willingness to join in with the imagination of God, and to see ourselves as part of a whole - the community of our church; the community of our ministries; the community of Glenvale; the community of other churches; the community of Toowoomba and beyond. Our willingness to see connection between and within these communities, and our capacity to see through boundaries, will enable us to grow even more so into a community church.

As we look forward, it will be important for us to not only ask 'what can we do at Lifeworks?', but also, 'Where is God already at work within our community, and how can we support that work?'

Uniting Care Queensland is providing funding for ministry placements as part of the 'Connect 100' initiative, which seeks to connect congregations with Uniting Care services and build relationships. Toowoomba has been identified as a site for a full-time Connect 100 ministry placement, and the Connect 100 team has identified Lifeworks as a potential host church for this placement.

This is a very exciting opportunity for Lifeworks, with the potential of having another full-time Ministry Agent on staff at Lifeworks, working some of the time with the congregation and some of the time with Uniting Care. If this role goes forward, it will be important for us as a whole church to own this ministry and be open to the possibilities of connecting with Uniting Care which has around 240 staff in Toowoomba.

If you could please pray for this role, and for this exciting opportunity that has come our way. God is good!


