

Introducing the new Presbytery Minister for the Presbytery of the Downs


We welcome to the Presbytery Rev Russell Reynoldson, who started on the 15th January 2026 on a two year appointment as Presbytery Minister during a critical time for the Presbytery of the Downs.

Russell has over 40 years' experience in ministry. He has diverse ministry experience in rural and urban congregations in Queensland and New South Wales and experience of community building and connecting churches with their communities.

The role of the Presbytery Minister in the Presbytery of the Downs is to provide pastoral care and oversight to Ministry Agents and churches within the Presbytery, and to be a key person in helping to navigate the Presbytery Capacity discussion which will almost certainly result in some Presbytery boundaries changing as the number of Presbyteries is reduced.

I had the pleasure of meeting with Russell soon after he commenced in the role and I believe he will be a valuable support to Lifeworks as we continue to work out what it means to be a church for Glenvale.

Russell has indicated his desire to visit Lifeworks and share a message with us, as well as meeting our people, so we will organise that in the coming months. - For Avarell Cockfield and Graham Beutel for good health.




