

Kingdom:Life

As we think about the Christian faith and our life as disciples of Christ, an important question we can ask is, 'what does it mean for me to be a Christian today?' In asking this question we recognise that it is more important for us to answer personally, rather than give an answer in some generic sense about what it means to be a Christian. In answering personally we 'own' the answer a lot more. The danger in generic answers is that they are for generic people that don't really exist, and we can be tempted to feel that this doesn't apply to us.

In asking this question we also recognise that our context is important. What does it mean to be a Christian *today*? How should we live our life and what do we believe in the context of 21st century Australia.

While we recognise the diversity in our answers to this important question, we do also recognise that we are asking what it means to be a *Christian*. In this way, it would seem that our answers should have something to do with Jesus Christ. Who is Christ for us? What did Christ say about being one of his followers? How would Christ want us to live today?

As part of our service on Sunday 5th March, we will all have the opportunity to share our answer to this question, with the proviso that we will keep this answer under a minute so that many can have a go. I encourage you to be part of that sharing. As for me, I like this quote I read yesterday from Albert Schweitzer, which seems a good answer for today:

"He comes to us as One unknown, without a name, as of old, by the lakeside, He came to those men who knew Him not. He speaks to us the same words: "Follow thou me!" and sets us to the tasks which He has to fulfill for our time. He commands. And to those who obey Him, whether they be wise or simple, He will reveal himself in the toils, the conflicts, the sufferings which they shall pass through in His fellowship, and, as an ineffable mystery, they shall learn in their own experience Who He is."
